Basic Computer Skills

Standard 1: Operating the Computer

1. The student will use the power button.
2. The student will identify monitor, keyboard, mouse, C.P.U.
3. The student will open and close programs.
4. The student will open and close a tab.
5. The student will turn on and turn off the computer following the appropriate steps and logging out of every program.
6. The student will write a U.R.L. on a browser.

Information Literacy

Standard 1: Searching Online

1. The student will practice searching for keyword definitions online.
2. The student will practice searching using "A Google A Day" website.
3. The student will practice browsing through a website and locating information with a specific question in mind.
4. The student will learn strategies to increase the accuracy of their keyword search.

Standard 2: Creative Credit and Copyright

1. The student will learn the term plagiarism.
2. The student will learn to validate a website (types of websites, author, last update, address)
4. The student will practice how to cite a site.
5. The students will learn to find images using licenses.

Standard 3: Email

1. The student will learn how to create an email account.
2. The student will learn how to send and receive an email.
3. The student will learn how to write a clear and respectful message.

Safety Online

Standard 1: Private and Personal Information

1. The student will explore what it means to be responsible and respectful of their online and offline communities.

2. The student will analyze the type of information which is shared online.

3. The student will learn how to create a strong password in order to protect their private information and accounts.

4. The student will analyze their own digital footprint.

5. The student will learn the difference between personal and private information.

Standard 2: SPAM

1. The student will learn to identify SPAM in email accounts and as advertisement.

2. The student will identify strategies for dealing with SPAM.

Standard 3: Privacy

1. The student will learn that children's websites must protect their private information.

3. The student will learn to identify secure websites for kids.

4. The student will learn the difference between fake and real websites.

5. The student will learn to put SafeSearch filters on a Gmail account and YouTube.

Communication Online**Standard: Cyberbullying**

1. The student will recognize the messages from other kids that can make them feel upset, hurt, sad or fearful.

2. The student will learn to identify actions of Upstanders or Bystanders.
