Basic Computer Skills

Standard 1: Operating the Computer

1. The student will use the power button to turn the computer on and off correctly.
2. The student will identify monitor, keyboard, mouse, C.P.U.
3. The student will open and close programs correctly by logging in and out.
4. The student will open and close tabs and open new windows.
5. The student will write a U.R.L. on a browser.
6. The student will learn how to reboot the computer.

Information Literacy

Standard 1: Searching Online

1. The student will practice searching for keyword definitions online and compare their results.
2. The student will refine their searches by using different words, synonyms or phrases.
3. The student will practice searching using "A Google A Day" website.
4. The student will learn strategies to increase the accuracy of their keyword search.

Standard 2: Creative Credit and Copyright

1. The student will learn what Copyright is.
2. The student will learn about Copyright Licenses.
3. The student will learn how to Create, license and publish their work.
4. The student will learn to validate a website (types of website, author, last update, address, etc.)
5. The student will practice how to cite a site.
6. The students will learn to find images using creative commons licenses.

Standard 3: Email

1. The student will learn how to send, receive and erase an email.

Standard 1: Private and Personal Information
