Basic Computer Skills

Standard 1: Operating the Computer

1. The student will use the power button to turn the computer on and off correctly.
2. The student will identify monitor, keyboard, mouse, C.P.U.
3. The student will open and close programs correctly by logging in and out.
4. The student will open and close tabs and open new windows.
5. The student will write a U.R.L. on a browser.
6. The student will learn how to reboot the computer.

Information Literacy

Standard 1: Searching Online

1. The student will be practice effective and efficient online searches.
2. The student will be practice differents searching strategies.
3. The student will practice searching using "A Google A Day" website.

Standard 2: Creative Credit and Copyright

1. The students will learn what copyright and fair use are.
2. The student will learn about Copyright Licenses.
3. The student will reflect about their responsibilities as creators and users of creative work.
4. The student will learn that anyone can publish on the web, so not all sites are reliable.
5. The student will understand fair use and create an original work of fair use.

Self-image & Identity

Standard 1: Gender Stereotypes Online (communication online)

1. The student will learn the difference in stereotypes between boys and girls.
2. The student will draw connections between young teens' perceptions of digital drama and stereotypes on men and women on reality TV.
3. The student will learn that presenting themselves in different ways online carries both benefits and risks.

4.The student will review their media habits and the array of media they use on a weekly basis, and reflect on the role of digital media in their lives.

5.The student learn that presenting themselves in different ways online carries both benefits and risks.

Safety Online

Standard 1: Privacy & Security

1.The student will analyze the type of information which is shared online.

2. The student will analyze their own digital footprint.

3. The student will analyze the repercussions of information shared on social media.

4.The student will learn strategies for guarding against identity theft and scams that try to access their private information online.

5. The student will learn that they have a digital footprint and that this information can be searched, copied and passed on, but that they can take some control based on what they post online.

6.The student will learn the difference between fake and real websites.

7.The student will learn to put SafeSearch filters on a Gmail account and YouTube.

Communication Online

Standard 1: Cyberbullying

1. The student will recognize the messages from other kids that can make them feel upset, hurt, sad or fearful.

2. The student will learn to identify actions of Upstanders of Bystanders.

3.The student will learn about the difference between being a passive bystander versus a brave upstander in cyberbullying situations.

4.The student will learn to distinguish good-natured teasing from cyberbullying.
